Year 6 Summer 1 - 2019

English

- In Literacy, we will be looking at:
 - Study Skills (reading focus)
 - Reports

Topic - Gallery Rebels Science - Light

- This half term our topic is called 'Gallery Rebels'. This topic looks at the history of art and artists throughout time. The children will have the opportunity to explore different periods of history such as expressionism, surrealism, cubism, realism and impressionism.
- In science, we are learning about Light, the children will identify sources of light & revise facts that light travels in straight lines & opaque objects form shadows. Understand that to see, light needs to enter the eye. Investigate light reflection & refraction, white light made of many colours.
- In Art the children will be working looking at complimentary colours, sculptures and impressionist art.
- In ICT we are following the 'Switched On' computing scheme. - We are APP developers
