English

- In Literacy, we will be looking at:
 - Take One Book - The children will study a book for 2 weeks and write using the text with a range of outcomes including diary entires, reports and monologues
 - Stories with flashbacks

Topic - Darwin's Delights Science - Evolution & Inheritance
