#### This week

It is great to see nearly every child in school wearing our school uniform including hair bows; thank you for your support with this.

I have looked at all of the children's views linked to their learning and feeling safe in school that they completed last week. The children have some great ideas and it is clear they are developing really good learning behaviours. It is great to see the vast majority of children feel safe in school and we talked about their ideas on how we could improve this further in school. Although we can't have electric fences as some suggested we are looking at prices for automatic gates and this will be something we consider when we set our next school budget. It was very clear how much they appreciate all staff in school and the support they give them as well as the support they get from their family.

We continue to remind children about how to stay safe on line. I am aware that sometimes when children search for a song or subject something that is not appropriate can find its way into their search. We will remind children about telling an adult if this happens. Please could you continue to support your child by checking what they have been watching. If you need help putting an adult only filter on your technology please let us know and we will be able to help you with this.

# **School Uniform Ordering**

We are now set up online for school uniform ordering. There is a link on the school uniform page on the school website that takes you to the site, we also sent instructions out to you on an email. If you would like a hard copy please contact the school office. We do still have some stock in school but have limited sizes.

# **Nut Allergy**

We have children in the school with serious nut allergies; we ask that you do not send your child into school with any kind of nuts in their packed lunch boxes.

#### **School Lunches**

Next week is week 3. If your child brings in a packed lunch please make sure they do not bring in peanut butter sandwiches or Nutella as we have children with severe allergies. Children in Years Reception to Year 2 are entitled to Universal Free School Meals and can have a free school lunch every day.

#### **Breaktime Snacks**

We endeavour to promote healthy eating at breaktimes, we have noticed that some children are bringing in packets of crisps and chocolate bars. We ask that you do not send your child into school with unhealthy snacks and swap them for fruit, raisins, rice cakes, fruit bars or send then in with 50p to purchase from our Tuck Shop.

#### **Nursery Applications**

If you have a child that will have their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday before the end of August 2018 they are eligible to attend Nursery from September 2018. All of the local schools are now dealing with Nursery Admissions themselves and you can no longer apply via the Local Education Authority. Please apply directly with your chosen school.
