School Uniform

School trips

We try and plan trips for all classes to support their learning. We sometimes need parent helpers. If you would like to help on any school trips please could you let your child's class teacher know. It maybe that we don't need all parents that offer for every trip and would ideally take parents who have a DBS check. If you would like to help on trips or in school please speak to the office about completing a DBS form.

Safeguarding

To ensure the safety of the children we ask that parents do not attempt to access the school office through any entrances near the classrooms. Should you need to come along to the school office you need to use the main entrance.

Some children in Years 5 and 6 are allowed to walk home on their own; please could you send a short letter/ email in giving permission or let the office or class teacher know so that they are aware of this. If someone else is collecting your child from school please could you let the office or teacher know as we are unable to hand children over to adults we have not had permission for.

Punctuality

Please try and make sure your child arrives on time every day. They are often upset if they are late and have to walk into the classroom when everyone else is settled. Thank you for your support.

School Lunches

Next week is week 1. If your child brings in a packed lunch please make sure they do not bring in peanut butter sandwiches or Nutella as we have children with severe allergies. Children in Years Reception to Year 2 are entitled to Universal Free School Meals and can have a free school lunch every day.

Attendance

It is really important that all children attend school every day. If you need any support in improving your child's attendance please come in and speak to Jules or a member of the senior leadership team.

Please do not book a holiday in term time.
