We have recently been looking at health and safety and Safeguarding issues in the school, we are concerned that parents and children are accessing the school out of hours. If your child has lost something, left something in the class or you would like to speak to a teacher, if it is outside of these hours, can you please wait until the following day.

Swearing

Teachers have explained to all children in school that we have a zero tolerance with regard to swearing. Although children may hear swearing out and about in the community it is important that they learn they cannot copy what they hear in school. There will be a consequence with a child missing their next break if they choose to swear in school.

Law change for using your mobile phone whilst driving

It is illegal to use a hand-held phone or similar device while driving, or riding a motorcycle - this is still the case stopped at traffic lights or queuing in traffic. Did you know? It is also illegal to use a hand-held mobile when supervising a learner driver or rider.

New penalties now mean that motorists and motorcyclists caught using a phone while driving and riding will receive six penalty points on their licence and a £200 fine. This means that new drivers, within two years of passing their test, run the risk of losing their licence for a single offence.
