



Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 6 Spring 2- 2020

English

- In Literacy, we will be looking at:
 - Non-chronological reports
 - Flotsam (Linked to World book Day)
 - Fantasy story writing
 - Explanation Texts

Topic - Darwin's Delights Science - Evolution & Inheritance

- This half term our topic is called '**Frozen Planet**'. We will be using globes and maps to identify the Polar Regions, comparing the Arctic and Antarctic. When we're more familiar with the Polar Regions, we'll write exciting stories and diary entries from the perspective of brave explorers.
- In science, we are learning about Electricity, the children will construct simple series circuits and create scientific diagrams to support them to pose and answer questions.
- In Art the children will be working with chalk and oil pastels and photographing ice
- In ICT we are following the 'Switched On' computing scheme. - We are interface designers

Mathematics

- This half term we are starting with looking at:
 - Order of Operations
 - Perimeter and Area
 - Fractions - multiplying/dividing/problem solving
 - Algebra and Sequences
