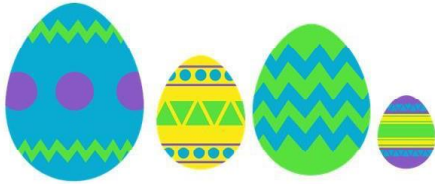
- Which activity will you choose today from your child's home learning packs?
