- Why not start writing a note at the end of each day? You go do this as a family or every person has their own.

All you do is write down something that has made you smile, laugh or looking forward to today. Put them into a jar or envelope and open them back up when IS all over and see how far we have come when we need a boost.

- An early Easter Maths Challenge. What if you put a ribbon around each of these eggs? Have a look at the photo with this email.

Ask your children to describe the length using words like longest, shortest, longer, shorter or any other. Send your answers back as we as submit them to Herts for learning for who came up with the unique answer.

Today we have some new challenges:

- Look around your home. How many different **2D shapes** can you find? (**Squares, triangles, circles etc.**) Take pictures of them, draw them, and name them.

- Can you also find any **3d shapes**? (**Cuboids, cubes, cylinders, sphere**). Take pictures of them, draw them, name them, and label them. E.g. cereal box is a cuboid.

- Why not listen to an audiobook. Choose a classic or one you have never hear of. Audible have some great free ones at the moment.

Once they have listened to one, ask your child to either retell the story with pictures and sentences, draw their favourite part or character and have them write about it.
