You might want to try some Easter activities too –decorate or design an Easter egg, use paper or card to make some numbered Easter eggs that you can hide, find and order or make an Easter card for someone, remember to write your name in it! Please feel free to e-mail me if you need anything or would like to share what you have been doing and I will do my best to reply to any e-mails promptly.

**Maths Challenge:**

Can you put the number cards from your home learning pack in the right order? Which number comes first when we are counting? Which number do we need next?

When you have ordered them, shut your eyes and ask a grown up to turn one of the numbers over. Can you work out what number it is? How do you know?

**Phonics Challenge:**

How many things can you find beginning with 't'?

Play a game of 'Silly Soup' using the things you have found:

"We're making lots of silly soup, We're making soup that's silly, We're going to cook it in the fridge, To make it nice and chilly, In goes . . ."

**Physical Development Challenge:**

Do some pegging –ask your grown up for some clothes pegs –how many can you peg onto a cardboard box?

**Or**

Do some threading –maybe you could thread cheerios onto spaghetti or laces into shoes.
