 - Design a packaging for a new Easter egg.
 - Imagine you are the Easter bunny and write a diary entry about a day you have had. Who did you see? Where did you go? What problems were there? What was your favourite part? What are you going to do tomorrow?
 - Follow a recipe to create a delicious Easter treat. Write about what you did in your exercise book.
 - Design an Easter basket that can carry Easter eggs.
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- Find out how Easter is celebrated in different parts of the world. Could you create a news report or an information poster/leaflet to teach others what you have discovered?
 - Plan an Easter egg hunt that others can try. Can you set up some clues and hide them in safe places around your garden?
 - Design an Easter card to send to a friend.
 - Create a poster about all the items linked to Easter.
