Literacy Challenge:

Creative Challenge:

Make your own St George's flag. I've attached some pictures to give you some ideas.

You might want to use pens and paper, you might want to use playdough, you could even use white and red clothing to make a giant flag on the floor.

Physical Development Challenge:

Re-tell the story using movements:

Flap your arms and pretend to fly like a dragon. Can you roar and breathe fire? Now dive into the lake.

Pretend to ride a horse like St George –can your horse walk, trot and gallop?

Can your horse jump over fallen trees and splash through rivers to save the princess?

Now be St George fighting the dragon –pretend to swing your sword from side to side, jump backwards and forwards to dodge the dragon's fire.

Now save the princess and gallop home on your horse!
