Phonics Challenge:

What else could you put in your picture that begins with /p/?

Mark Making Challenge:

In your second 'Home Learning Pack' you should find a blank treasure map.

If you don't have it or have already used it, don't worry, you can just use a piece of paper.

Can you make your own treasure map? Hide the treasure that you made yesterday somewhere in your home.

Draw a map to show where the treasure is hidden. Remember to write a big 'X marks the spot' to show where the treasure is!

Physical Development Challenge:

Have a pirate adventure on your hunt for the hidden treasure.

You could use a box, the sofa or a cushion for your boat. Sit in your boat and row, row, row.

Uh, oh, there's a hole in your boat, use an imaginary bucket to scoop, scoop, scoop the water out!

Keep on rowing, you need to get to your pirate island.

Get out your telescope and look left, look right, look all around, there's the island!

Row faster, faster, faster! Now carefully climb out of your boat and swim the last bit to the island.

What will happen next in your pirate adventure? Will you have to dodge sharks or crocodiles?

Will you have to climb over rocks or balance across logs on your way to find the treasure?

How deep will you have to dig? Good luck and let me know if you find any treasure!
