Literacy Challenge:

Listen to the story 'Kipper's Birthday' by Mick Inkpen.

Draw a picture to list the different things Kipper needed to celebrate his Birthday.

Maths Challenge:

Kipper needed balloons.

Make some balloons by drawing and cutting out big circle or oval shapes.

How old is your Teddy going to be on his/her Birthday?

Write numbers on your balloons to show how old your Teddy is going to be.

Keep your balloons somewhere safe for Teddy's Birthday party on Friday!

Physical Development Challenge:

Practise your musical statues.

Dance to the music and when it stops, freeze! Don't move or you're out!

Ask a grown up to stop and start your favourite tune for you.
