Literacy Challenge:

Make a Birthday card for Teddy.
Carefully fold a piece of paper in half.
What will you draw on your card? What message will you write inside?
Remember to write your name so that Teddy knows who the card is from.

Creative Challenge:

Make some pretend food for the party.
What kinds of food will you need? How much will you need?
How will you make your food?
Maybe you could draw and cut different foods out of paper or cardboard?
Or you could use playdough. Or maybe you've got another idea.

Physical Development Challenge:

Wrap Teddy's present.
Ask an adult for some wrapping paper or make your own by decorating a piece of paper.

Tomorrow is May Bank Holiday so I won't be setting any challenges but here are some ideas for tomorrow if you want to do them.

You should be all ready to celebrate Teddy's Birthday now so you might want to have Teddy's party tomorrow.
Put up your decorations and gather Teddy's friends together.
Give Teddy his/her present and card, remember to read the card to him/her (Teddy might not be able to read yet).
Do some dancing and play some party games like 'Musical Statues' and 'Musical Bumps.'
Share the party food that you have made with Teddy and his/her party guests -make sure you share things fairly.

Tomorrow is also VE Day which marks the 75th anniversary of the end of World War 2 in Europe.
Included in your 4th Home Learning pack are some related activities that you might want to do –you should find a Spitfire plane to make, some bunting to decorate and a medal to design.
