2. Today we are starting another new book. It is called Varjak Paw. We will be reading Chapter 1 and 2 today.

- a. Who is Jalal? Why is he important?
- b. What colour is their fur? What type of cat are they?
- c. How would you describe Varjak Paw?
- d. Who is Julius and how does Varjak feel about him? Do you think this is fair?
- e. What do you think will happen next?
- f. Writing Challenge – Choose one of the cats and draw a picture of them, writing a descriptive paragraph about them.

3. Museum – First we need to design our witch or wizard. This will be our main character for our museum this week. Design your own witch/wizard. You could base it on yourself, or from a book, or even design a brand new character. Draw a picture and include descriptions of what they look like. They will also need a uniform – they might wear a cape or a hat. You could even use things from around the home (ask an adult first) to create your own uniform for your character.

4. Count the triangles you can see in one room. Are there different types of triangles that you can see? What are the different names for these triangles? What is different about their sides and angles?
