**English task-** Make sure you are up to date with your explorer writing booklet (it is behind the maths work in your latest pack).. Today's task is to complete the page with the imitation sentences starting with adverbs.

Choose some facts from the text about Rhiswanozebtahs that you would like to include in the sentences and make up some facts of your own. For example : **Interestingly**, these delightful creatures can often appear shy but are actually the largest living creatures since Pterodactyl dinosaurs. **Unbelievably**, they can grow up to 5 metres in length- longer than a double decker bus!

**Mymaths task:** This week we are looking at statistics (tables and graphs) Here is the support video to help you. Remember you can have more than one try. Often children who get 100% have had 2 or 3 tries- fantastic
