3. Carnivals – Today we are looking at Mardi Gras. Mardi Gras is a day people indulge in rich food and celebration before lent. There are many other names for Mardi Gras – such as Shrove Tuesday, Fat Tuesday or Pancake Day. Mardi Gras is celebrated all over the world but the largest celebration is in New Orleans. The main colours are Green, Purple and Gold, representing Faith, Justice and Power. People create floats, outfits, jewellery and masks.

- a. Design your own Mardi Gras Mask. You could draw it, make it with cardboard or find materials around the house – make sure you ask an adult. Remember to include the main three colours – purple, gold and green.
- b. Research New Orleans and make a fact file.
