**Minibeast Challenge:**

Draw the pictures for your story and ask an adult to write the words for you. Remember you can help them by telling them where to start writing, which direction to write in and by helping out with initial sounds and sounding out words with your robot arms.

Send me photos of your stories if you can and I will read them to your friends in school.

**Maths Challenge:**

Listen to our number formation rhyme again.

This time make sure you join in and practice writing your numbers in the air with your finger.

Pause the video in between numbers and have a go at writing each number with pen and paper or with your finger in a tray of salt, flour or glitter.
