Today's challenges are:

- Roman Museum - Roman shields were important as they protected the soldier but could also be used as a group to create a protective barrier known as the tortoise shell. Roman shields would be painted with something important to them or to their group – known as a legion. Senior Roman soldiers would pay a craftsman to paint their shield with famous battles or myths. Design your own Roman shield – you could simply draw it on paper, or use recycling or materials around the house to create a real life shield. Remember it is important to protect you so think about size when you are designing it.
- How can you be a good friend at the moment? Think about how you can be a good friend to people in your home and also people you cannot see right now.
- Make up your own animal. Think about where they live, what they eat and what they need to survive. You could base it on a real animal or create one completely from scratch. Create a fact file of this animal.
