- **Writing Task** – During this week, you are going to write your own newspaper article. Today I would like you to **plan** your article about ‘schools reopening’. In your plan you should include the Headline, sub-heading, The 5 Ws – who, what, where, when and why, direct quotes from members of the public – teachers, parents, children or MPs. Think about how many paragraphs you are going to write and what each paragraph will include.
