Minibeast Challenge:

Design a minibeast habitat. Draw your design on paper today and ask a grown up to help you label it. Tomorrow you will make your habitat and later in the week you will make some more pretend minibeasts to live in it.

It could be for just one kind of minibeast or for lots of different kinds of minibeasts.

Think carefully about what you learnt about minibeast habitats yesterday to help you.

Think about how you will make your habitat too –what materials will you use?

I have attached some pictures to give you some ideas.

Maths Challenge:

Find your number cards 1-10.

Choose a number and make a caterpillar with that many segments to its body.

You can use anything you like to make your caterpillar –lego bricks, playdough balls, socks, cheerios threaded onto spaghetti or anything else that you can think of.

Now choose another number and make another caterpillar with that many segments.

Which caterpillar is longer? Which is shorter?
