3. Carnivals – Today we are looking at Kite Festivals. The Festival of the Winds is Australia's largest Kite-Flying Festival. The Hamamatsu Giant Kite Festival in Japan is unique because the kites are rectangular in shape. In Guatemala, the kites of Sumpango – huge circular kites – are flown as part of the Barrilete Festival. In Indonesia, The Bali Kite festival includes gigantic flights which can have 100 metre long tails.

- a. Design a poster advertising one of the kite festivals.
- b. Design your own kite. You could base it on one of the festivals or make your own. You could design it on paper or even make it using things you can find at home – remember to ask an adult first.
- c. Research other kite festivals and compare the differences. Which one would you like to visit most and why?
