- a. What does Elder Paw tell Varjak he must do?
- b. What does Varjak have to go and find and bring back?
- c. How do you think Varjak feels looking up at the wall?
- d. Find all the adverbs on page 45 describing how Varjak climbs up the wall.
- e. Writing Challenge - Imagine you are Varjak and you have just made it to the top of the wall. Write a descriptive paragraph of what you can see and how you feel. What are you going to do next?

3. Museum – We now have our magical witch/wizard and an incredible magical home for them to live in. Your witch/wizard needs a magical pet. You might want to use an animal and make it magical or design your own brand new mythical creature. You could make it a creature that can help them perform magic, or something they can use to travel with. Does the creature have its own special magic? Create a fact file of your pet. 4. Make your own playdough. You will need flour, salt, oil and water. Mix them together and knead well. You could even add food colouring and make different colours. Remember to ask an adults permission first.
