Here is what we would like you to complete today:

- **Maths** – In the third home learning pack (after the writing section – Doors) Please complete Year 6 Maths Activity Mat 4. The answers are on the back of the sheet so that you can mark your work.
- **My Maths** – I have set some more tasks on My Maths for you. Try not to complete them all in one go – maybe pick one a day. The tasks set today expire on **6th July** so you have a week to complete them.
- **Reading** – Please read a chapter from a book of your choice and summarise what has happened in that chapter. If it is a book that you have not read before then you can also predict what you think might happen next. If it is a book that you have read before you can pick three words to describe the main character and explain why you have picked those words.
- **Writing Task** – In the third learning pack sent home there is a page titled ‘Year 6 Taskboard’ pick one of the writing tasks from that (free choice) and complete it in your exercise book
- **Online programmes** – You have access to Spag.com, TT Rockstars, Spelling Shed and My Maths, log on and use them daily. You were given all your log in details in the packs sent home but if you have any issues with log in details or passwords please contact us and we will try our best to resolve it for you.
- **Science** – Please complete pages 40 and 41 ‘Reversible and Irreversible Changes’ from the Science CPG book. Remember to mark your work afterwards to see how you got on.
